Dear Coach,

The enclosed paperwork is the necessary step toward moving your Affiliate Chapter to the status of Charter Chapter.

Charter status does not entail more dues to the NFL than does Affiliate. Charter status allows your school to vote on District and National NFL elections for District Committee and Executive Committee, respectively. Your vote will be indexed to your chapter's current NFL members/degree strength.

Also, and more importantly, your chapter may send its full quota of students to the NFL Mid-Atlantic Congress National Qualifying Tournament. Under NFL rules, an Affiliate may only send two students to the Senate and two students to the House. Once your application to Charter is approved by the District Committee, your school will be able to send your full complement to the Congress Qualifier this year.

Finally, we are offering Mid-Atlantic Charters copy of the NFL Final Tapes in DI, HI, Duo, Prose, Poetry, and Storytelling. These tapes, transcribed to DVD, are invaluable assets to preparing your students for local, regional, and national competition.

Charter status requires that your school maintain 1,000 NFL points over a three-year period. This requirement is a minimal one and many schools have that mark well-within your grasp.

Complete the pages following this one and send the three pages to the FAX number listed at the head. The forms are able to be typed on your computer and then printed out. We will need the appropriate signatures on the form. Student signatures are needed for the Charter member certificate that will be sent your school by Nationals. We will then forward your application to the members of the District Committee. The NFL Mid-Atlantic District Committee is committed to encouraging all qualified schools to move to Charter status. We hope to get your application's status back to you as soon as possible.
